

Principal Teacher – Cory Goei Biography:

A West Michigan native, Cory received his early training with the School of the Grand Rapids Ballet. He continued his training with scholarships to the Joffrey Ballet, Houston Ballet and the Cleveland/San Jose Ballet. Cory began his professional career in 1997 performing leading roles with the Dayton Ballet and Ballet Met in Columbus, Ohio. On return to Grand Rapids in 2001 Cory spent four seasons with the Grand Rapids Ballet.
