

**Ludolph Arens Piano Scholarship  
Information and Audition Requirements  
Blue Lake Fine Arts Camp 2012**

1. Students interested in the Arens Piano Scholarship should submit an audition recording, completed camp application, and a deposit of \$200.00 no later than March 15, 2012. Students should enroll as a piano major in Blue Lake's Piano Program, and will be notified when audition results have been finalized. Auditions will not be considered without the completed application and deposit on file. Because Piano enrollment is limited and can fill quickly, it is in your interest to register early – even if your Arens audition has not been submitted.
2. Audition results will be mailed shortly after the March 15 deadline. Students awarded the Arens Piano Scholarship will receive a Maximum Merit Scholarship toward the cost of tuition. Students not awarded this scholarship will be given the option to remain enrolled or withdraw.
3. The audition recording should consist of one complete work from the published collection of pieces composed by Ludolph Arens. This collection may be purchased from Blue Lake Fine Arts Camp by calling 800-221-3796. Total cost for the collection (including shipping) is \$20.00. A CD recording of the complete Arens collection recorded by pianist Stephan Heib is also available through the Blue Lake office for \$20.00. Please note that all scholarship winners will be required to perform their audition piece while here at camp.
4. Only compact discs are accepted. DO NOT use any form of reverberation or acoustic altering effects in your recording. Label your audition recording and case with your name, "Arens Piano Scholarship," and the specific piece you have recorded.
