

**Shakespeare Scholarships for Theater Campers  
Information and Audition Requirements  
Blue Lake Fine Arts Camp 2012**

1. Submit your audition recording, completed camp application, recommendation letter, and a deposit of \$200 no later than March 15, 2012. Students will be initially enrolled in Blue Lake's Shakespeare Program until audition results have been finalized. Audition results will be mailed shortly after the March 15 deadline. Students not awarded this scholarship will be given the option to remain enrolled or withdraw. Auditions will not be considered without the completed application and deposit.
2. Only DVDs are accepted. Please use proper video authoring software (iDVD, DVD Studio Pro, Roxio, etc.) to burn your audition to the disc. If you just drag, drop and burn a Quicktime or similar file to a DVD, it will become a data file and will not play as a video.
3. Label your audition DVD and case with your name and "Rose Scholarship." List track numbers and contents on case.
4. Include each of the following on your audition DVD:
  - a. A dramatic / serious Shakespearean monologue; about 2 minutes.
  - b. A comic Shakespearean monologue; about 2 minutes.
  - c. A statement explaining your reasons for studying Shakespearean acting.
5. Judges will be looking for the following:
  - Vocal clarity (diction and support).
  - Clarity of character and circumstance.
  - A clear, effective and appropriate dramatic structure.
  - Grounded and meaningful physical choices.
  - Comic timing and honest emotional connection, respectively.
6. Please include a letter of recommendation from your theatre teacher and/or director outlining your acting ability and citizenship.
